

Programs

IEP (Intensive English Program)

There are six levels of intensive English classes at RC. Each level includes conversation, pronunciation, grammar, reading, and writing. The purpose is to give students a grasp of academic writing, critical reading, and fluent speaking to be able to enter the TOEFL® preparation course and achieve their educational and professional goals. The six levels start with the alphabet and end with high level college preparation. Students are taught in pairs or small groups, which enables teachers to monitor their progress individually. By working together in small groups, students increase their appetite for learning and absorb the teacher's professional instruction in a short period of time.

Classes are held Monday thru Friday. Students can choose to attend morning or afternoon classes (Semi-intensive course) which consist of 18 hours per week, or both morning and afternoon classes (Intensive course) which consist of 36 hours per week.

Pre-beginning (ABC)

Students develop survival communication in English, obtain fundamental knowledge, gain comprehensible pronunciation skills, and increase their motivation and interests in learning English.

Beginning

Students are introduced to basic grammar, vocabulary development, dictionary use and pronunciation of the phonetic alphabet.

Intermediate

Students are introduced to American idioms and writing structures. Speaking and listening is developed at a simple level, as students learn communicative strategies to express thoughts and increase comprehension.

High-intermediate

Students focus on writing basic to complex sentences, interpersonal communication skills, intermediate grammar, pronunciation and writing skills.

Advanced

Students focus on more intensive practice in reading, writing and speaking; fluency in mechanics; and reading longer, more complex articles. Students learn high-intermediate grammar and practice in discussion groups.

High-advanced

Students focus on more frequent writing practice and advanced grammar. They start to prepare for the TOEFL or TOEIC examinations and college or university courses.


TOEFL® Preparation Program


International students who wish to study at a community college or university in the USA are required to pass the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL®). This test measures the English language ability of international students who are planning to enter the academic world. In this program, students will use textbooks specifically designed for the TOEFL® iBT (Internet-based). We strive to build up students' strength in writing and speaking as well as in listening and reading. Rosemead College (RC) is an official TOEFL® iBT test center, so the students can take the exam on campus.

The school is equipped with a state-of-the-art computer lab. Students study in the computer lab where the actual test is administered.

The TOEFL® Preparation Program includes the following:

- ✓ Use textbook with actual TOEFL® iBT format questions
- ✓ Test-taking skills
- ✓ Regular simulated practice tests





TOEIC® Preparation Program

TOEIC® is the Test of English for International Communication. TOEIC® test measures the ability to communicate in English, in the business world. TOEIC® score is important at job interviews in various countries. This program is recommended for students hoping to get positions in the business filed. Students who studied at Rosemead College (RC) scored over 800 out of 990 on average. Rosemead campus is an authorized test center of TOEIC® and the test is held monthly.

Programs

Conversation & American Culture (Course Description)

This course focuses on current events and cultural topics in English. Students further develop their pronunciation, vocabulary, idioms and conversational skills. This real-life focus familiarizes and accustoms students with the diversity of American Culture and increases self-esteem and confidence in using English in their educational and personal lives.

Course Learning Outcomes

The objectives of this course are to familiarize students with the many different aspects of American culture such as greetings, gestures, dating, tipping, safety laws, health, holidays, education, shopping and values. As students are introduced to certain topics they will be able to converse and convey their personal opinions, argue a point of view, and share and discuss experiences.

Students will be able to understand and make inferences from conversations and talks regarding academic and social topics. Clear English pronunciation, including stress and intonation will be emphasized and demonstrated through using authentic materials to stimulate students' oral communication skills.















College & University Recognitions

Business English (Course Description)

This course focuses on the practical application of principal language skills with emphasis and focus on the basics of business writing and oral communication in business related situations or contexts. Students are given a firm base and effective knowledge of business English.



Course Learning Outcomes

The objectives of this course are to introduce students to problem solving, critical thinking and professional communication through integrated skills. The emphasis is on how to use formal vocabulary and expressions in business-related environments both orally and in written form. Students develop productive skills through group/pair work, presentations, discussions and role-plays.

The communicative functions include practicing moderating skills, form-filling, writing cover letters and resumes, discussing global issues that affect the business world, developing time-management skills, creating action plans, decision-making, placing orders, participating in meetings, giving formal presentations, reading and discussing Job advertisements, and analyzing different sales situations. To this end, extensive pair and group work, listening comprehension exercises, reading, and writing is carried out. Students will be exposed to simulated business situations and introduced to authentic business-related materials.

Students will be able to demonstrate their abilities to communicate in a variety of business settings and interact in English using comprehensive business skills.

















Registration requirements for overseas students

Please follow these steps to obtain an F-I Visa.

After following these steps, students should receive F-I Visa from the US embassy within 5 to 7 business days.

STEP 1

Send us the required documents

(Please refer to the checklist below)

STEP II

Wait for our documents

- 1. Receive an I-20
- 2 . Acceptance Letter from RC

(3-10 business days after we receive required documents and fees)

STEP III

Attend the interview at the American Embassy

Overseas Students required documents checklist

- 1. Completed Application form
- 2. Photocopy of Passport
- 3. Financial statement*
- 4. High school diploma
- 5. Payment of fees

* Acceptable forms of a financial statement are a personal bank statement or a letter from the bank. However, if your parents/sponsor will pay for your expenses during your stay in the U.S., parents/sponsor needs to fill out the Affidavit of Support Form, which you can download from our website. In that case parents/sponsor has to provide a bank letter.

Registration requirements for transfer students

If you already have an FI visa and are planning to transfer to Rosemead College, please prepare the following documents in order to process your request.

Transfer Students required documents checklist

- 1. Completed Application form
- 2 Photocopy of your passport, student visa, I-94 and I-20 Form
- 3. Financial statement
- 4. Signed Transfer Form, High school diploma
- 5 Your current school's telephone & fax numbers
- 6. Payment of fees


